Presentation:- **The 360° Project Manager**

Organisations are adopting an ever increasing number of models to improve their projects and services. Best practice models such as PMBOK, Prince2, or ITIL, are adopted to improve the professionalism of project and service managers through individual certification. Improvement models such as CMMI are used to improve the maturity of the organization. Governance models such as COBIT or PMI's and OGC's standards for programme and portfolio management are implemented to put in place the proper decision making structures and to implement strategic performance management. Agile/Lean approaches are adopted to deal with uncertainty and change.

This presentation introduces the 360° project manager. This project manager abandons the “model fundamentalist” philosophy that is characterised by a one-size-fits-all, universal solution. Rather, he or she uses recurring patterns (tailoring guidelines) for interpreting the different best practice models, using them in combination to design an effective approach that is highly adapted to the specific organisation and project's needs.
