Presentation:- How can we make PMI South Chapter the Best in the UK?

Come along to this innovative meeting to give your feedback on how we can make the PMI South Chapter the best it can be. This meeting will take the format of an OpenSpace event and will be run by David Hinde of Orgtopia.

Openspace was invented by Harrison Owen. He noticed that during all the conferences and meetings he had attended, the most productive times were nearly always during the coffee breaks, chatting to like-minded people about issues that interested them. So he came up with a new approach. The method facilitates a group to focus on a particular challenge. There are no set agendas, no chairperson and no-one is forced to spend time listening to a discussion that does not interest them.

Some people call an Openspace event an “Un-conference” or an “Un-meeting.” People set their own agenda of mini-discussions to tackle a range of group-selected topics. They then decide which of the mini-discussions they would like to attend. They could go to one, many or none at all. They can sit and listen or participate. The topics are recorded and then the group comes together at the end for a debrief.

Openspace events are fun, innovative, dynamic and sometimes chaotic. Prepare to be challenged, confused, excited and motivated!

David Hinde runs a management consultancy called Orgtopia. His work is focused on developing leadership and management skills in a range of blue chip companies and public sector organisations. He also works as a Prince2 trainer and has prepared thousands of candidates for the accreditation examination. TAKE THE DUAL CARRIAGEWAY TOWARDS THE TOWN CENTRE. AT THE FIRST ROUNDABOUT, JOIN THE A339. LEAVE THE A339 AT THE NEXT EXIT (SIGNPOSTED CAR PARKS AND BUSINESS AREA). TAKE THE NEXT EXIT (SIGNPOSTED BASING VIEW BUSINESS AREA) PASSING UNDER CHURCHILL WAY. SNAMPROGETTI HOUSE IS THE LARGE RED BUILDING LOCATED IN FRONT AND TO THE LEFT.

From M4 (J.13)
TAKE THE A34 FROM NEWBURY, AND PROCEED SOUTHBOUND. TURN INTO AND FOLLOW THE A339 WHICH GOES TO BASINGSTOKE. (SEE INSET).

From M4 (J.11)
EXIT THE M4 MOTORWAY AT JUNCTION 11 AND TRAVEL SOUTHBOUND ON THE A33, WHICH GOES TO BASINGSTOKE. FOLLOW THE A33 TO THE READING ROAD ROUNDABOUT, WHERE THE A33 MEETS THE A339. (SEE INSET).
